The Rafting Marathon will be organised in accordance with the WRF Sport Rules (www.worldraftingfederation.com).

Participation Fee

The Registration fee for the All India Rafting Marathon Series – Himachal Pradesh is Rs. 15000/- (Rs. Fifteen Thousand Only) per team which includes Accommodation and Transportation from 24 to 28 September 2023 we request you to bring your own rafts – 14 ft or we can help in hiring the same for your team.

Registration Procedure

There is no limit for teams' number for each organisation / state teams / clubs:
An athlete may compete in different categories. For each team a substitute can be registered. The substitute for a Mixed Teams has to be a woman.

No later than 30 June 2023. the teams can register their teams via email to info@fwwfi.com with the **numeric entries** (indicating the number of people composing the Delegation).

Transport

During the official training and competitions will be present an ambulance with doctor.

Security at the venue

Water safety
